The food and craft booths will be open on Friday, May 27 from noon until dusk, and on Saturday, May 28 from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm. Vendor parking will be available just off 100 North on 100 and 200 East. We also have space for a limited number of RV/Trailer parking that will be given on a first come first serve basis.
